1. Introduction

Based on the extensive clinical experience, the high patient volume and the productive academic environment, the Musculoskeletal Tumor Center at Seoul National University Cancer Hospital (SNUCH) aims to be the world's premier training center for academic orthopedic oncologists. The Musculoskeletal Tumor Center at SNUCH has over 30 years of experience of treating patients with musculoskeletal tumors. These include the group of entities of bone sarcomas, soft tissue sarcomas, benign soft tissue tumors, benign bone tumors and metastatic disease to the bone and soft tissues. The Musculoskeletal Tumor Center annually performs over 700 operations and treats close to 2000 new patients. Over 10 studies performed at the Musculoskeletal Tumor Center are published in peer-reviewed journals annually.

2. Orthopedic oncology fellowship program

Musculoskeletal tumor center offers orthopaedic oncology fellowship designed to provide specialized training in the multidisciplinary care of benign and malignant bone and soft tissue tumors. The orthopaedic oncology fellowship program at Seoul National University Hospital is over 20 years old, and it is the most comprehensive in Korea. We offer one- or two-year fellowships. The one-year fellowship focuses on clinical orthopaedic oncology training, both operative and non-operative. The fellows will be able to participate in 3-4 teaching conferences per week, such as case conference and sarcoma tumor board. Fellows will experience co-ordinated multi-disciplinary care encompassing medical oncology, radiation oncology, pathology, radiology and various disciplines of surgery. Fellows will be able to participate in 2 to 3 clinical research projects during this year. The two-year fellowship prepares fellows for academic careers in musculoskeletal oncology. The fellows will be provided with an opportunity to participate in basic research focusing on cancer biology.
