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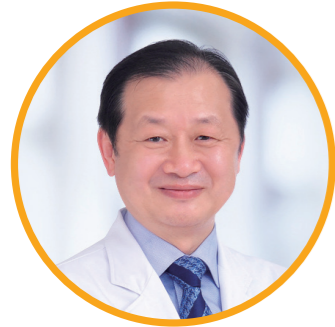

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Greetings from the Director of the Integrative Care Hub



Greetings.
I am Hee-young Shin, the director of the Integrative Care Hub of Seoul National University Children's Hospital.

Pediatric patients who are under medical care for life-threatening diseases and their families will experience physical, psychosocial, financial, and spiritual difficulties in the process of at times complex and uncertain care. The integrative care hub, which incorporates the functions of the children's hospital school, Dreamseeds (pediatric palliative care team), and emotional center (pediatric psychiatric counseling) was opened to solve these various problems in 2018 and provides multidisciplinary team collaboration and professional medical services. In 2019, Dreamseeds published "My Own Garden," a workbook for pediatric patients, and "A handbook of advanced care planning for medical staff," which is widely used by many institutions including Seoul National University Hospital. In addition, a platform was created on which Dreamseeds' homepage and applications were set up for easier communication and feedback. Dreamseeds will always be with patients and their families to improve their quality of life.

Year 2020 is gyeongjanyeon, the year of the white rat in Chinese zodiac sign, or the year of "abundance, opportunities, and hopes." We hope that the year 2020 will be filled with hopes and opportunities for all patients and parents.

Introduction to Children's Hospital School

The Children's Hospital School is a formal educational establishment that supports children with childhood cancers and leukemia who cannot attend school for an extended period due to their treatment. The support includes classes and educational activities to prepare them for their return to school. The first class was held in the Seoul National University Hospital on July 15, 1999 and currently there are 34 hospital schools in operation nationwide. Annual nationwide symposia and scholarship meetings are held to discuss the management of each hospital school as well as effective educational activities



At the Children's Hospital School :

- One allocated classroom is in operation for children diagnosed with cancers and leukemia on the seventh floor of the Children's Hospital.
- There are six main courses including Korean, English, Mathematics, Science, Music, and Art, and five extracurricular courses including historical experience learning (The National Museum of Korea), art therapy, dance therapy, craft, and creative experience (juggling). In addition, there are creative experience activities such as visiting regular schools, return-to-school programs, small group meetings of middle school students, adolescent counseling and career education, and club activities.
- Once a child is diagnosed, classes are conducted after counseling with the hospital school counselor (youth counselor.) The child is placed in the return-to-school program to facilitate his/her return to school on completion of medical treatment.
- Information of all classes and events are uploaded to the homepage, and online registration is possible.



The emotional center (pediatric psychiatric counseling) was established in May 2013 to provide patients at the Children's Hospital and their families with psychological health and psychosocial support services. Patients and their families are supported to maintain mentally healthy lives, even during medical treatment. Through psychosocial support during treatment for various diseases, patients return to society as physically, mentally, and socially healthy members after treatment.



At the emotional center (pediatric psychiatric counseling) :

At the emotional center (pediatric psychiatric counseling) :

- Counseling by a specialist from the Department of Psychiatry.
- Hospital-based therapeutic play by nurse practitioners.
- Psychological, emotional, and learning assessments.
- Counseling on development and education by a psychiatric advanced practice nurse.
- Education counseling related to school adjustment and career.
- Services including family support counseling and information related to social welfare.

The emotional center (pediatric psychiatric counseling) conducts a free program (healing art) where Children's Hospital patients and their siblings can participate without the referral of a practitioner. Healing art is an art therapy program (sponsored by the Hyundai Motor Chung Mong-Koo Foundation) where stress is managed and one's body and mind are taken care of through visual language art.



Dreamseeds (pediatric palliative care team) provides medical help and psychological and emotional support to patients treated for life-threatening diseases and their parents. The team started in January 2014 with the goal of filling the day of children and parents with meaningful moments.

The Pediatric Palliative Care Team :

- Actively controls the pain and symptoms of the child being treated.
- Provides care with the medical care team rather than terminating their on-going treatment.
- When the child and family have to make an important decision about the current situation, we share their concerns.
- Respect the values of the child and family and provide physical, emotional, and social support
- Support not only the child under treatment but also important family members such as parent and siblings.
- Provide necessary resources to resolve difficulties that occur due to changes in the treatment environment such as outpatient care, intensive care unit (ICU) care, and discharge to home.

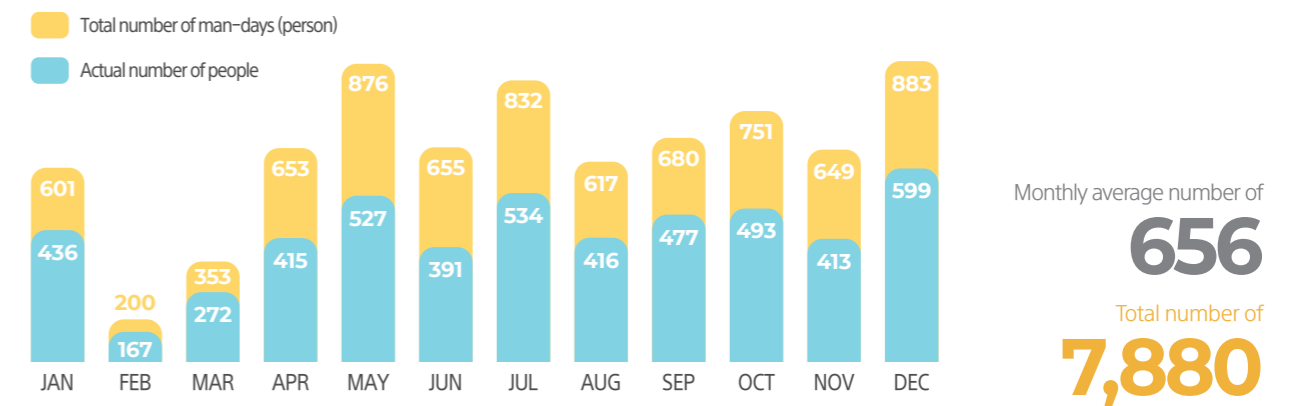

Dreamseeds Center and 1:1 volunteer program statistics (1. 2019 - 12. 2019)

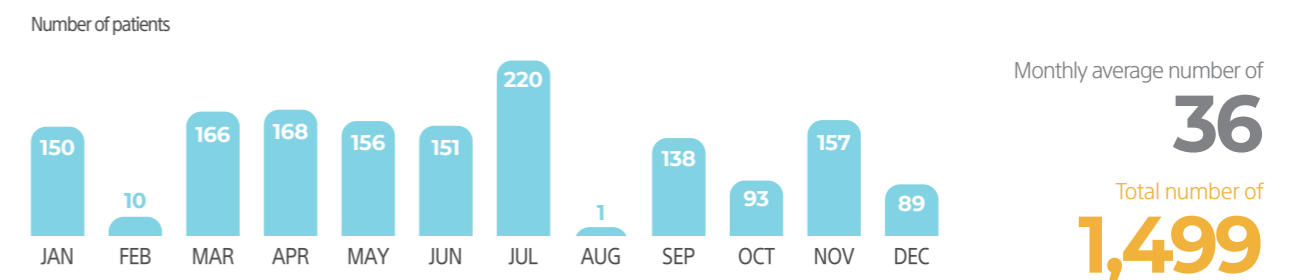
1. Number of visitors to Dreamseeds Center

- Monthly average number of people admitted to Dreamseeds Center was 656, and the total number of admissions in 2019 was 7,880.
- In January 2020, the number of Dreamseeds Center users was 2,773, which was an increase of 280 newly registered patients with Dreamseeds Center compared to 2019 (2,493 patients).



2. Number of Ward Patients 1:1 volunteer program to Dreamseeds

- For patients who cannot visit the center because they are isolated or non-ambulatory, Dreamseeds Center visited (linked to) the ward where the patient is.
- Dreamseeds Center was linked 36 times per month on average excluding February and August during which volunteers were recruited and trained and the total number of visits (linking) in 2019 was 1,499.



3. Dreamseeds Programs Statistics

Dreamseeds Center planned and operated a total of 239 programs (13 regular programs and 8 one-time programs) in 2019 providing programs to 1,100 patients and parents. 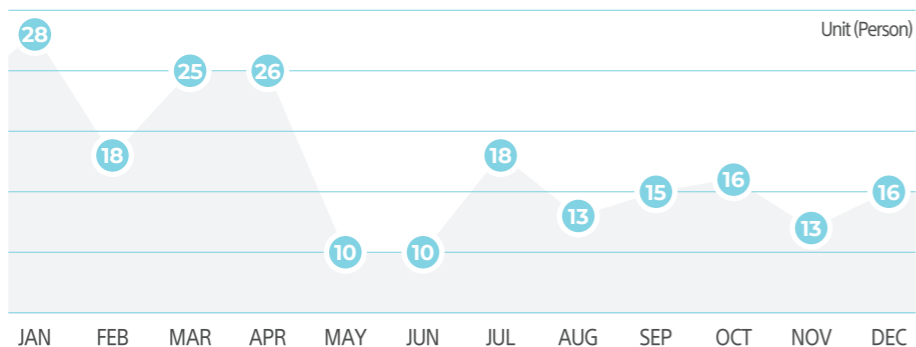

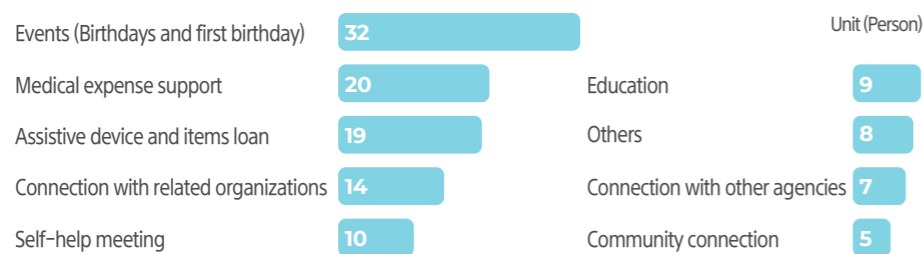

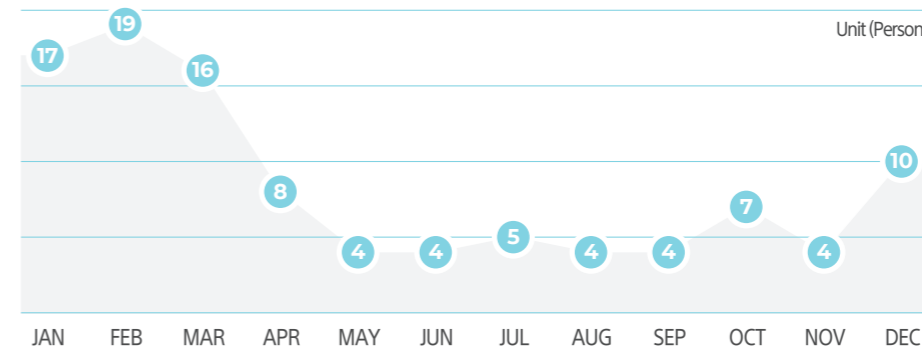

- The number of newly referred patients to the pediatric palliative care team in 2019 was 208, the total number patients intervened, including newly referred patients, was 564, and the total number of interventions was 10,273.
- The highest number of interventions where the pediatric palliative care team met children in person, was 3,064. This was followed up with phone calls, text messages and on duty visits of 2,125 cases. These interventions were about 50% of all interventions, and we made efforts to continuously communicate with patients and their parents to assist.
- There was a total of 124 resource connection cases including connections for education purposes, assistive devices and items loan, connections with related organizations and communities for supporting medical expenses, and others.

- The total number of patients referred to home care in 2019 was 102. The current status of intervention is that 70 patients are being intervened, 14 patients are on the waiting list, 11 are unregistered patients, and 7 patients are discharged.
- In 2019, the total number of home-care interventions by different professions was 1,116, which included 118 cases by medical doctors, 531 cases by two visiting nurses, 428 cases by physical therapists, and 89 cases by occupational therapists.

6. Research Related to Dreamseeds

In 2019, research related to Dreamseeds was conducted as described below. The pediatric palliative care team of Dreamseeds believes that research related to pediatric palliative care is important to improve the quality of care, build capacity, and to contribute to the healthcare system as well as policy. Dreamseeds will continue to identify, investigate issues surrounding our everyday practices, and to develop evidence to guide pediatric palliative and home care practice.

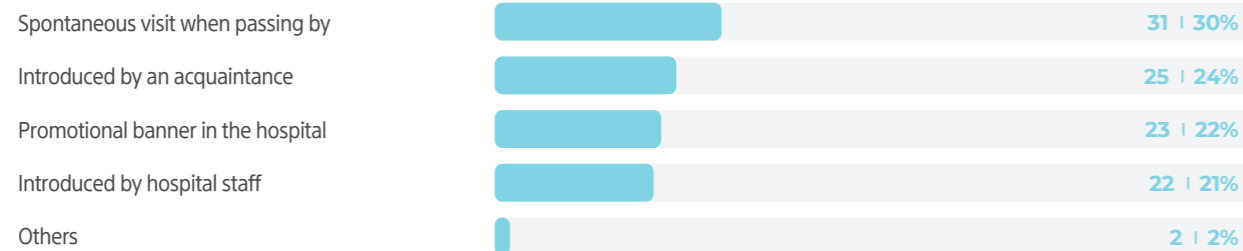

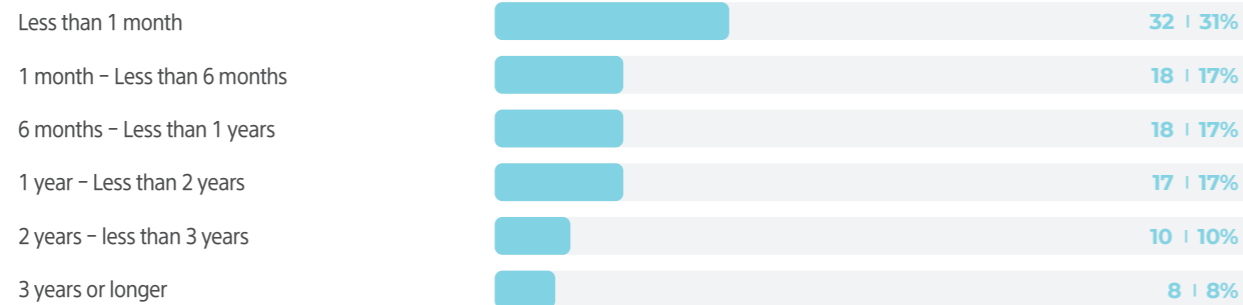

(1) 1. How did you find Dreamseeds Center?

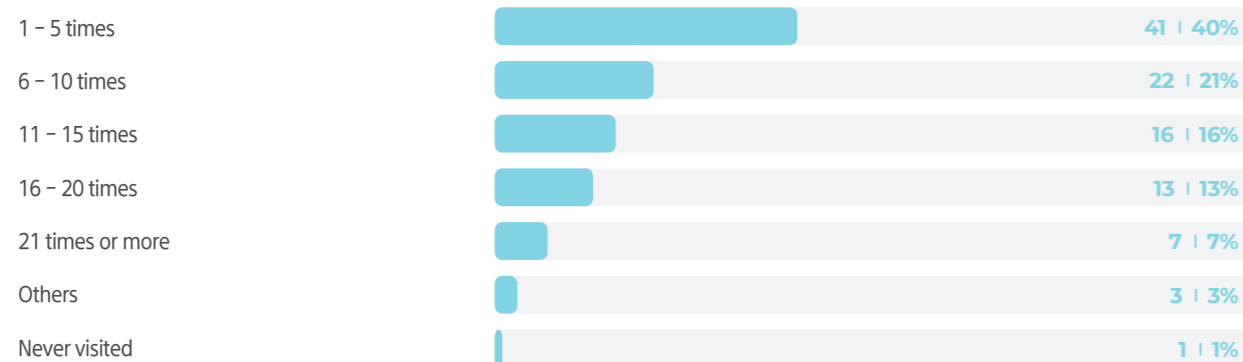
Number of responses | Ratio



(2) How long have you been using Dreamseeds Center?

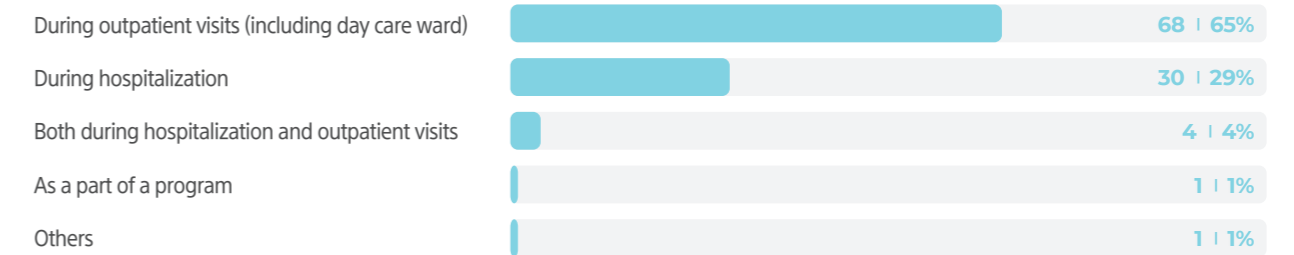


(3) How many times did you visit Dreamseeds Center last year (2019)?

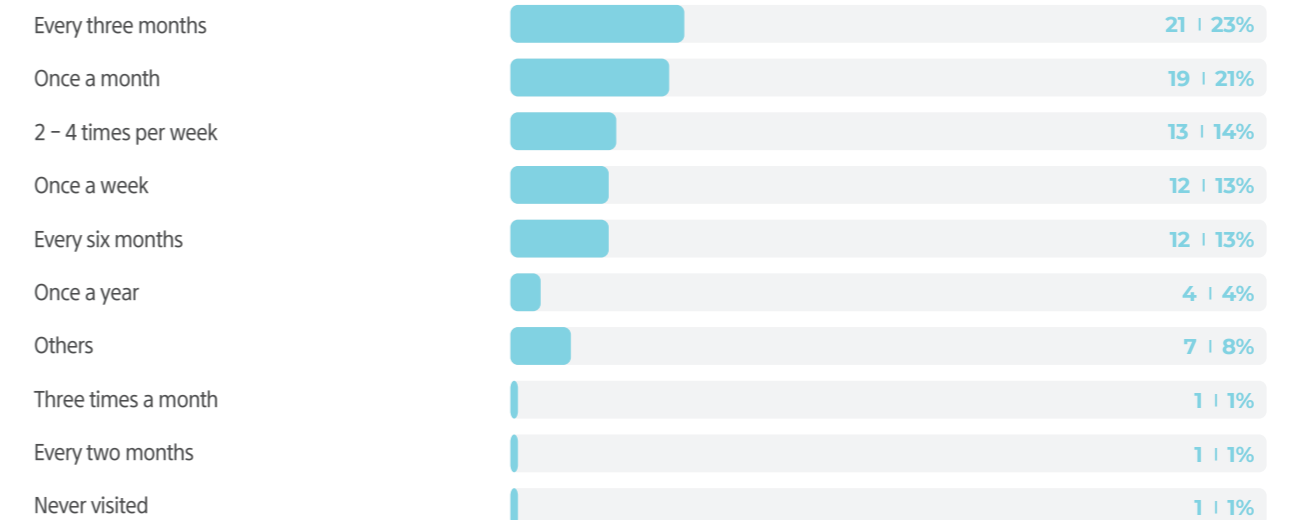


(4) When do you usually visit Dreamseeds Center?

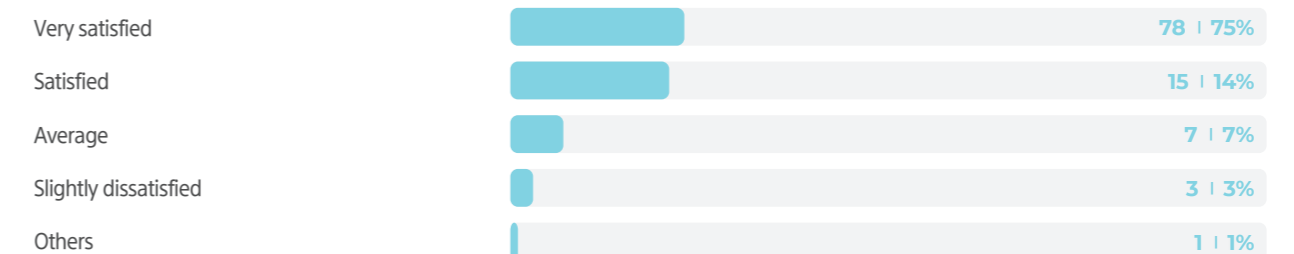

Waiting for outpatient care and providing rest [35 responses]

- I stayed here the whole day as the waiting time was long and I had to see several doctors. The volunteers spent time with the children and the staff members were kind. They tried to help as much as possible and I am very thankful for it.
- This is a great place to rest without the children getting bored while waiting for medical care, because there are various toys and I can also have tea.
- We had to wait at least two hours, and I am so happy that Dreamseeds Center is there for us to wait without being exposed to the risk of infection.
- Dreamseeds Center is very useful because there is no proper place to rest in the hospital. Such as using a gastrostomy tube, breast feeding the baby and changing diapers.
- It was difficult to struggle alone when my baby was hospitalized, and it is nice to have Dreamseeds where I can take a small break.
- I am very grateful because mothers can have a little bit of time off.
- The safest place in the hospital.

Improvement in the perception of the hospital [14 responses]

- Being in the hospital is difficult for inpatient children because they have nowhere to play and it makes parents weary. The space called Dreamseeds makes both parents and children happy because children are given the opportunity to play with toys, clay, etc., with the assistance of Nanumi volunteers – rather than living in the smartphone world or ward. In addition, I think it is a great place for both children and parents because it created a palliative care team to take care of sick children, while it became a place parents can rely on. It is so nice to see children come to the hospital, full of fun and positive emotions because Dreamseeds make children think that a hospital is not a scary and torturous place. They can resolve difficulties and stresses from hospital life and the hospital is a fun place and playground, therefore preventing fear of and aversion to the hospital. I am afraid that I talk a little too much, but my conclusion is that children and parents take heart to overcome the difficulties of hospital life because of Dreamseeds.
- My child has great physical and psychological difficulties coming to the hospital, but greatly enjoys the activities at Dreamseeds.

Center staff and programs [22 responses]

- All the staff members are and it is great to comfortably use Dreamseeds during outpatient visits or hospitalization. We watched many puppet shows and received many gifts, thanks to good timing, in 2019, and we really appreciate it. Coming to the hospital to take tests is difficult and painful for my child, but because of Dreamseeds, my child comes to the hospital in a good mood and I am always thankful for that.
- The staff are kind and there are various programs. The variety of toys is also good.
- I am greatly satisfied and thankful towards Dreamseeds for their attention to small details.
- Thank you for the gift of joy while waiting and special time spent with my child who is always depressed or tired.
- You always kindly play with my child, tailored for my child and I can feel your warmth.
- I like the outstanding Nanumi volunteers and various programs.

(6-2) If you answered that you are not satisfied, please tell us the reason. (Please describe)

Center environment [9 responses]

- Not enough space to change a severely sick child. Too noisy because programs are focused on cognitive and ambulatory children. I wanted to feed my child through a gastrostomy tube, but there was no space to fit the wheelchair.
- Small space for the number of sick children and cleanliness is questionable because some parents do not disinfect the toys.

Center use and reservations [9 responses]

- Sometimes we were not able to use Dreamseeds because it was fully reserved.
- There are not much to do for adolescents (except for board games).

Dreamseeds will listen closely to the opinions of users and reflect them as much as possible to improve comfort.

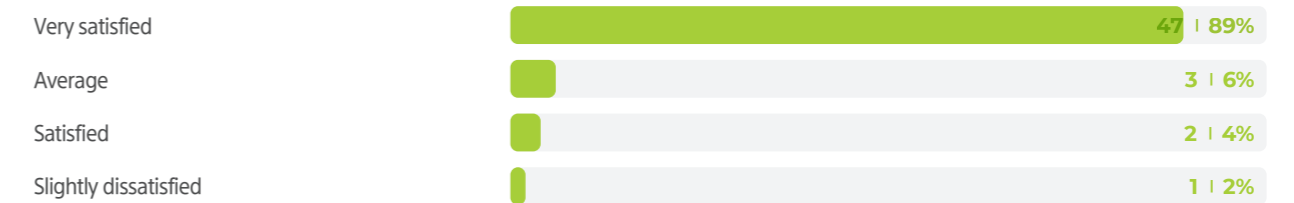

Reservations

• I would like to make use of the service, even if hospitalization is for one day only.	▶ Dreamseeds also wants to meet more friends, but because it is difficult to meet everyone, the following rules were established. Dreamseeds connection patients who have been hospitalized for one week or longer and are connected if the attending physician has requested a referral to another department. We politely ask for your consideration for children who are hospitalized for longer periods.
• Hope we have more connections.	▶ The ward connection schedule is constantly adjusted according to the number of inpatients and we will contact you if we have a vacancy. Please understand, however, that children whose previous connections were canceled due to their conditions or treatment schedules will be contacted first.

Activities

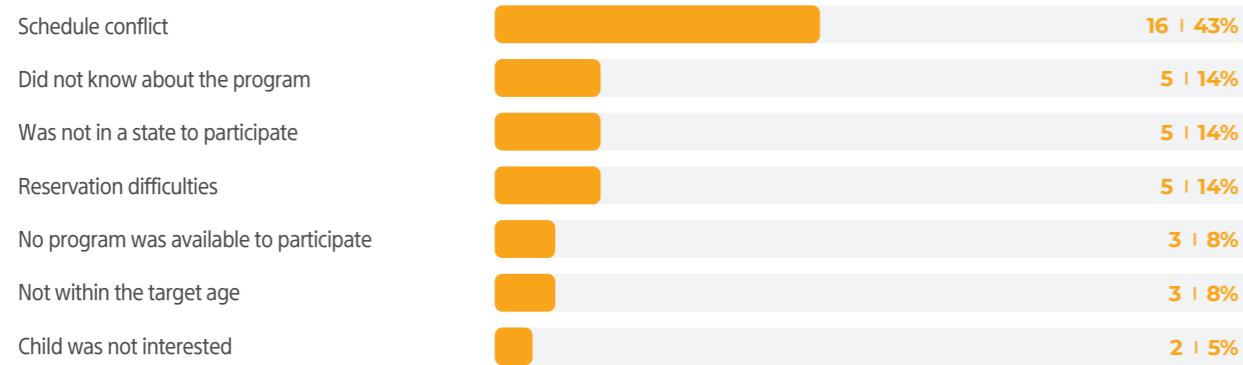
• Ward connection time seems to be a little short. In addition, you sometimes come 10-15 minutes later than the scheduled time.	▶ For activities with more children, ward connection time is set to be 1-2 hours by rule. We will also guide everyone to better follow the activity time announced in advance.
• Please be fully knowledgeable of the necessary action to take per sick child.	▶ We conduct orientation and education for new volunteers for better understanding of patients. We will instruct them again about the understanding of activity articles and attitude toward activities.
• There were occasions when the volunteer used a smartphone next to a child for a long time. Please take care of children, even if they cannot express themselves well.	
• Sometimes play sessions did not go well due to the wrong toys and your unfamiliarity with the game.

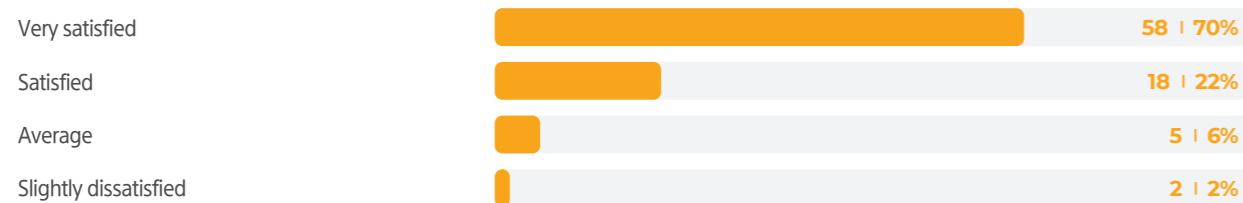
(1) Have you participated in group programs conducted at Dreamseeds Center before? Number of responses | Ratio



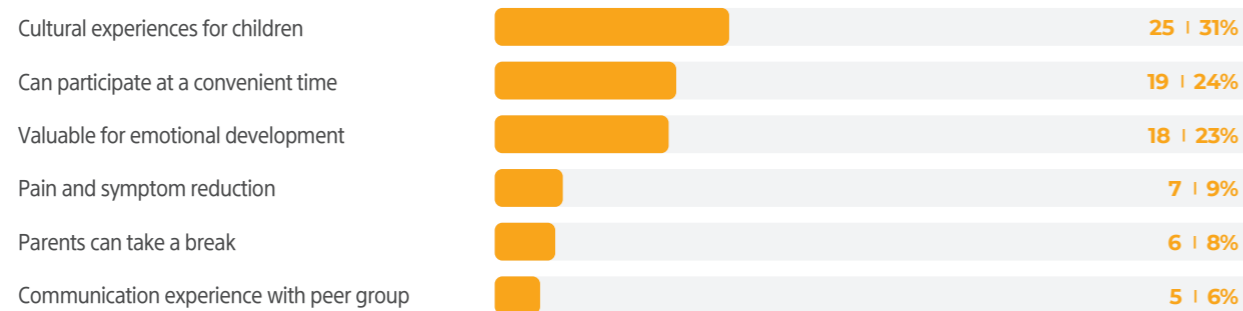
(1-1) If you have not participated in Dreamseeds' group programs before, what is the reason?



(2) What is your opinion on the overall group programs of Dreamseeds?

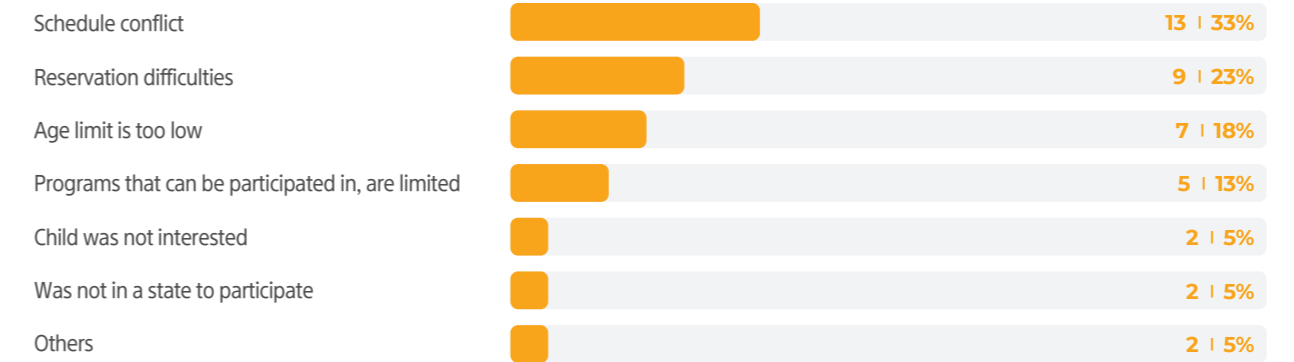


(2-1) If you responded that you are satisfied, please select a reason. (You may select more than one)

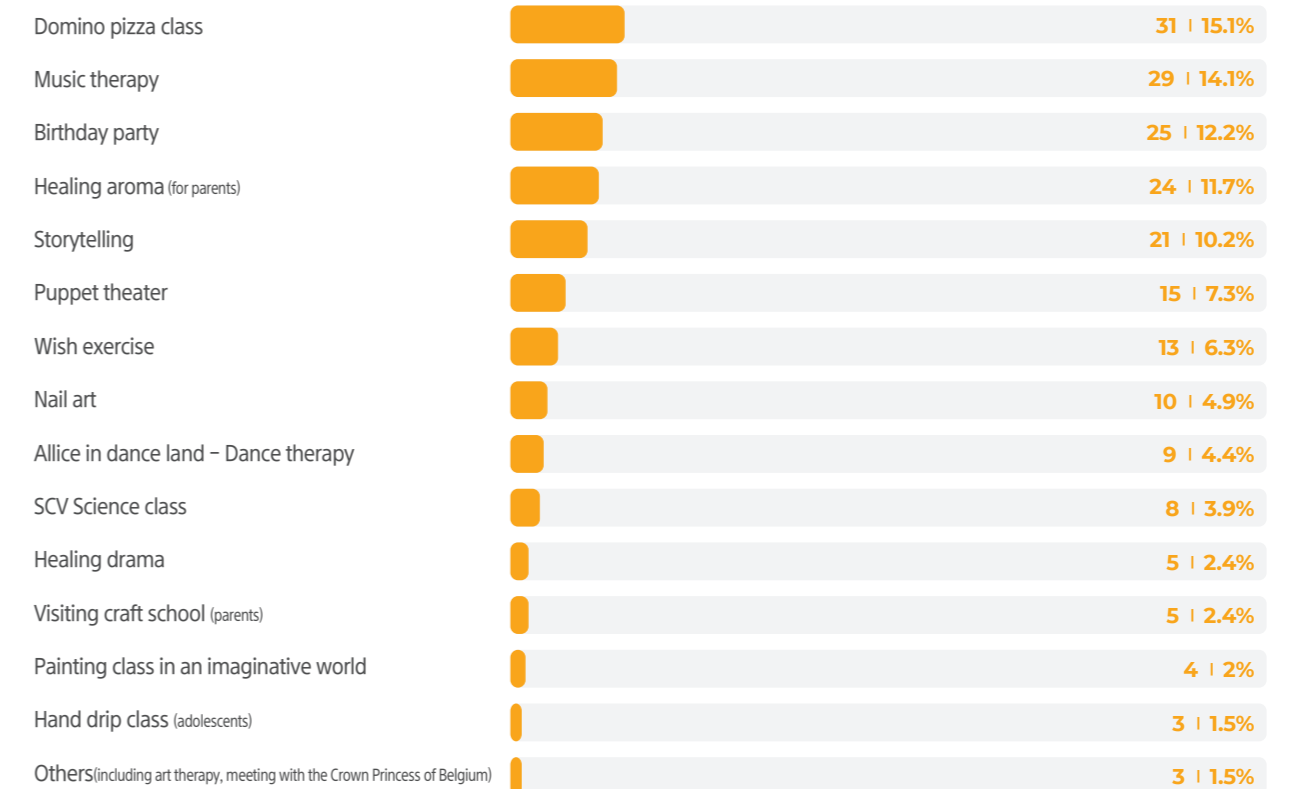


(2-2) If you responded that you are unsatisfied, please select a reason.

(3) Among the programs you participated in, please select a program or programs that you liked. (You may select more than one)

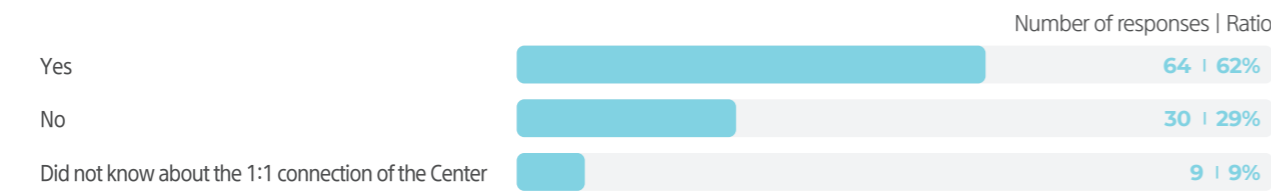

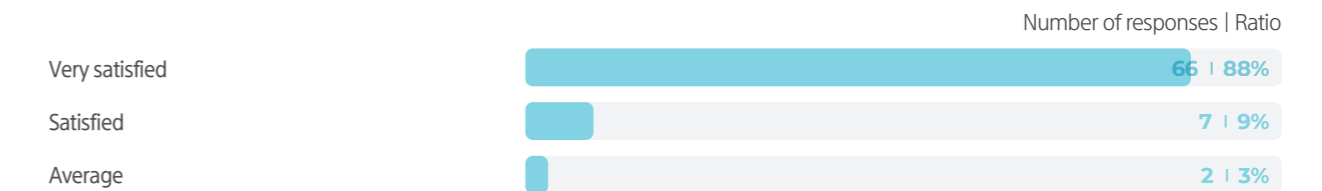

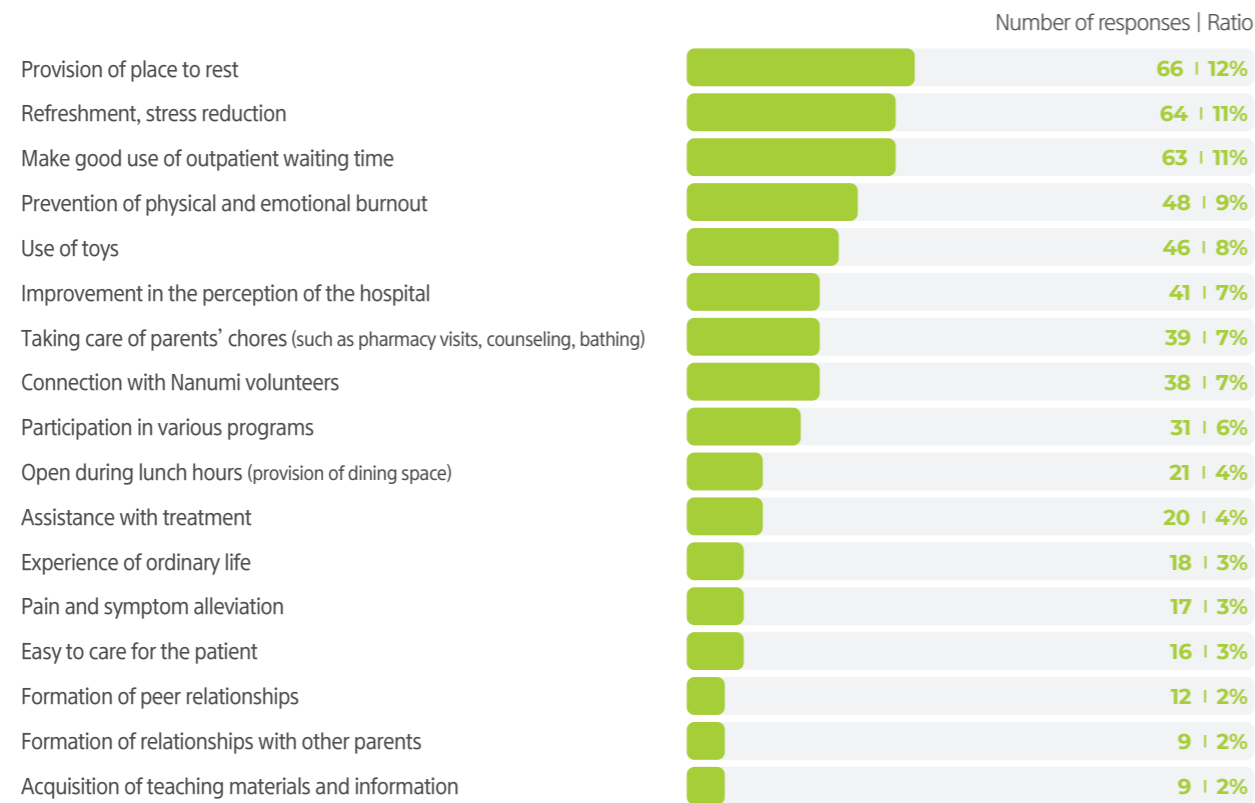

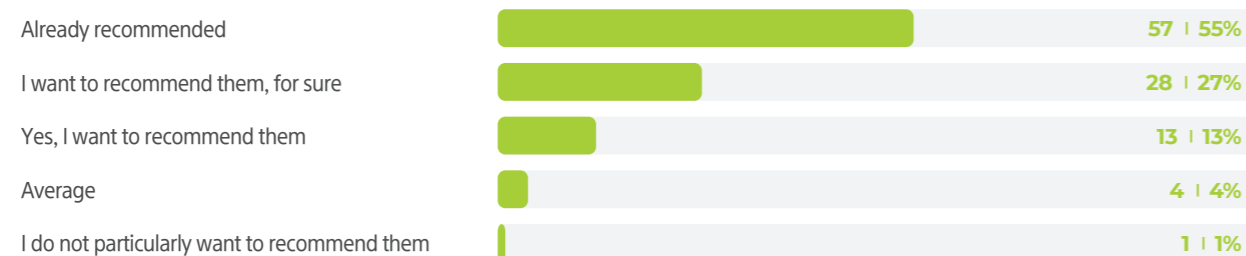

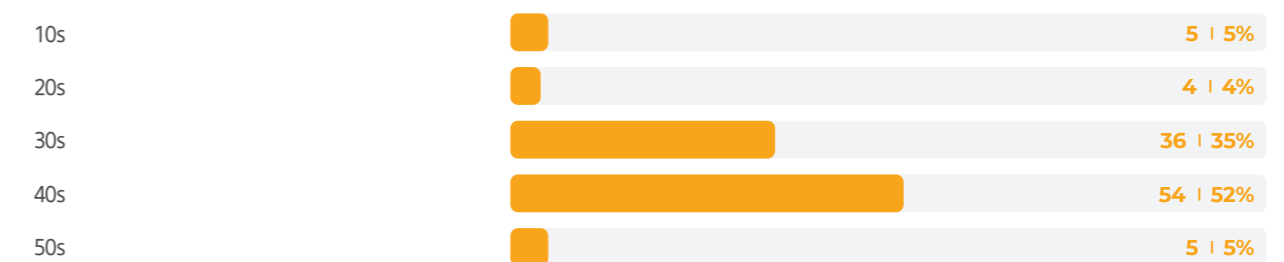

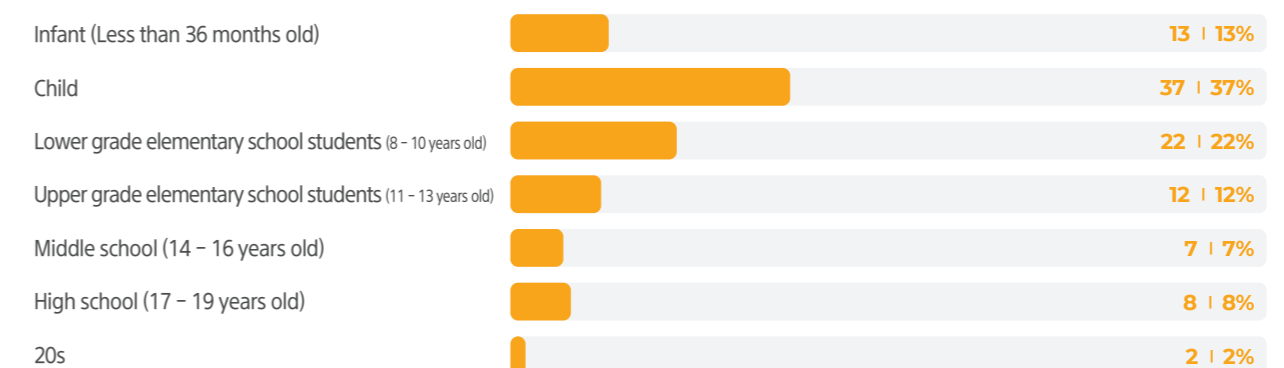

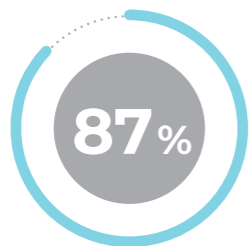

Visit of the Crown Princess of Denmark and delegation



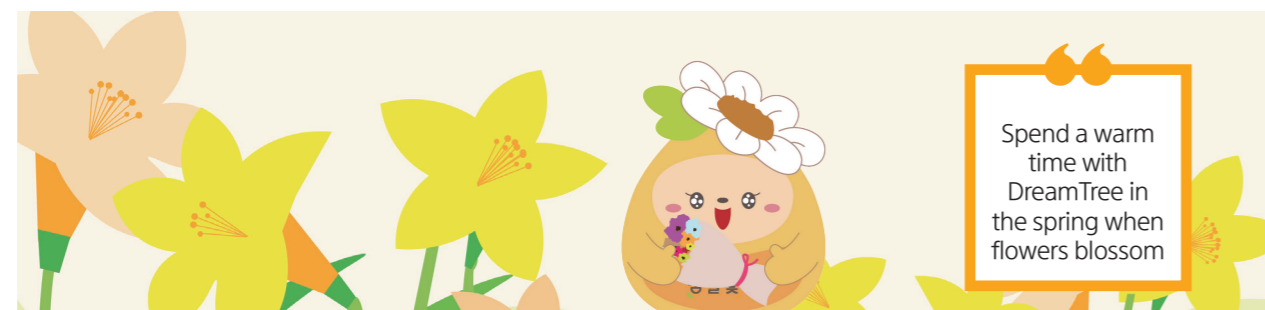
May 22, 2019

Q. Please introduce yourself.

A. Hello everyone! In October 2013, when I was in 6th grade, I had a large painless bruise on my leg. It was a bolt out of the blue to be diagnosed with acute aplastic anemia. In January 2014, an angel donated precious stem cells, which was implanted, but I was not discharged even once due to response to the host implant. I endured the psychological and physical pain due to treatment and long hospitalization, with the help of Dreamseeds. In August 2015, I was finally discharged and, skipping middle school, I entered a high school that I wanted to attend. Although I did not understand well, I was focused and even had a safe field trip in which I had a lot of fun with friends. I participated in everything I could without skipping school, despite some difficulties before I graduated. Now, I have entered university where I can go one step further into the wide world.

Q. Can you briefly tell us about the treatment process, its difficulties, and things you liked?

A. The toughest part was the long hospitalization and the constant arguments with my mother. I was not able to eat well due to the medication after several surgeries I had to undergo. The doctors had found fungus in my lungs due to the implantation. What I liked was that Dreamseeds was established at that time and I was able to find the bright side of me I had before I became ill as I was doing a lot of activities in Dreamseeds, who prompted me to find a new path for my life.

Q. Can you tell us about a typical day in the future you dream of?

A. I was exhilarated to be admitted to the university I wanted to attend as I thought that I would not be accepted, due to my high school grades. Now I want to achieve small goals at college. I want to study hard to achieve my dreams and to dream of the future as I enter into and adjust to social life in college, which is different from high school life.

Q. Please say a word to Dreamseeds.

A. I think Dreamseeds is "The Giving Tree" for sick children and their parents. I want to thank Dreamseeds for helping me to find the original cheerful Ji-hye Seo and flourish into the future.

Q. Please introduce yourself.

A. Hi everyone. My name is Gang-rok Son and I am 20 years old. I was diagnosed with acute myeloid leukemia for the first time in 2013. I had transplantation at the National Cancer Center but had a recurrence in 2016. I was successfully treated at Seoul National University Children's Hospital and currently receiving treatment as an outpatient.

Q. Can you briefly tell us about the treatment process, its difficulties, and things you liked?

A. When I first heard that I have leukemia, I do not think I had emotions such as sorrow or fear. Since I was young at that time, I barely had any fear because I did not know much about leukemia. I finished the transplantation without difficulties but feared drawing blood and disliked eating.

As I returned to middle school and continued ordinary school life, I heard that I had a recurrence. I felt desolated. "Can I go through the process again?" "Once the treatment is over, can I go back to my life?" I was lying in a hospital bed and felt heavy with so many thoughts. I even had nightmares which I never had before.

I found a way to shake off such emotions by looking at myself from a step away. Rather than being scared and stressed with thoughts about sickness and symptoms, I trusted the doctors who have been seeing so many patients. After that, I believed that they would manage to resolve any problem. In difficult times, I could manage negative emotions by thinking that it would go away in the blink of an eye anyway. I was also able to cheerfully pass the time in a stuffy hospital room, thinking about and searching for things I would like to do once I go back home. I imagined that I was taking a break on the way back home. You may consider it as escapism, but even if I think about it now, I think what sick children need is to be free from any burden and stress. They should be carefree, rather than seeing the reality.

Q. Can you tell us about a typical day in the future you dream of?

A. Despite so many physical and mental difficulties during the treatment process, cheerfully spending one day at a time as if the day is slipping through the fingers brought me to the end of the treatment process before I knew it. I am on the verge of returning to my ordinary life. I am very excited since I am going to college this year, but at the same time, I am a little scared. I do not feel suffocated anymore, though. I believe that if I do what I have to do as always, everything else will solve itself.

Q. Please say a word to Dreamseeds.

A. I would like to say this to everyone who is under treatment. Please be patient. It is acceptable to relax a little because time will solve what bothers you. If you take one step at a time, it will be over soon; you don't have to be stressed by small things. I wish you all complete your treatment without a problem.

Stories of friends who completed treatment



Q. Please introduce yourself.

A. Hi everyone. This is my seven-year-old darling Hyeon-u Gong.

Q. Can you briefly tell us about the treatment process, its difficulties, and things you liked?

A. My son was diagnosed with a brain tumor medulloblastoma when he was 4 - 5 months old and had hematopoietic stem cell transplantation without radiation twice. The problem was that he was not able to touch, meet others or experience normal things at a young age, because of hospitalization.

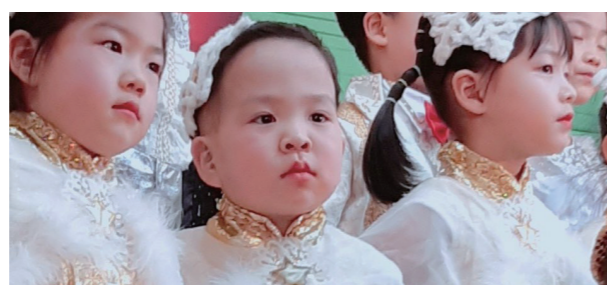
What we liked was that we were not alone. My son was not lonely because he had big brothers and big sisters acting like real siblings, even though they had different illnesses as well. I had other patient whose presence was a great support and I could share the days that were filled with difficult treatments.

Q. Can you tell us about a typical day in the future that Hyeon-u may dream of?

A. As the treatment is coming to an end, we are talking about things that we were not able to do or wanted to do. We will continue to do so, all the way. It may be not much to others, but Hyeon-u will live meaningful days one day at a time as he achieves one by one. It may be slow and small, but he will march on toward splendid days without giving up!

Q. What is Hyeon-u's biggest interest these days?

A. He is very curious lately. "Why? What is it? Why does he do it?" He has been looking low in spirit, but he is at the age where he is curious about everything. With his nonstop questions, my energy is frequently depleted; he also likes to create something and be praised. Nonetheless, the matter of fact is that his deepest affection for robots and dinosaurs doesn't change! It is a secret that these days he is impatiently waiting for a robot movie that is going to be premiered soon.



Q. A word to Dreamseeds!

A. Pediatric patients and their parents also call Dreamseeds "love." Dreamseeds is like a kids' cafe, a playground to children with cancer or severe disabilities. Dreamseeds shines because of staff members who treat each child warmly. On the contrary, if there is no staff member at Dreamseeds, the place will not shine. Dreamseeds always support you.

We introduced you to changes to Dreamseeds in 2019-2020. Dreamseeds will work with our friends and their families so that they will receive medical treatment in a better environment.

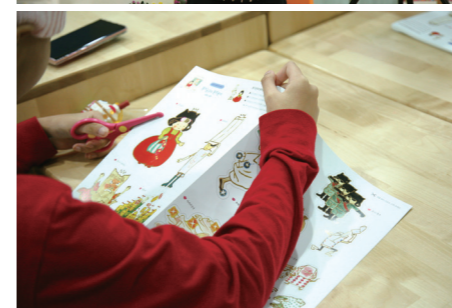

1. Your work

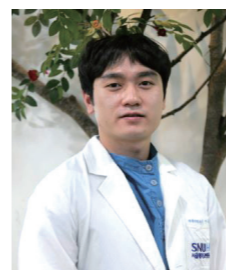
I am a pediatric home care nurse. I visit children's homes and check if they have any difficulties.

I am a physical therapist in charge of pediatric home care. I am part of the home care team and my main work is home-based physical therapy.

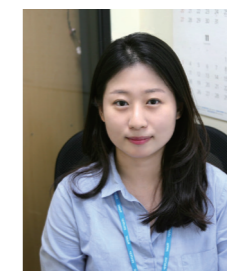
2. Where can I see you?

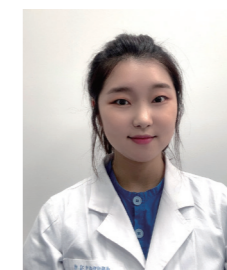
I am a social worker. I oversee planning, promoting Dreamseeds Center programs and work related to government subsidies.

Introduction to the home care pilot project

A pilot project for home care of critically ill pediatric patients is carried out since January 2019. This is for severely ill patients who are 18 years or younger, have medical needs (home respirators, oxygen therapy, airway aspiration, home total parenteral nutrition, nasogastric tube-feeding, enteral feeding, and self-catheterization) and resides 30 km or less from the hospital. The number of critically ill pediatric patients increases due to the development of modern medicine. These patients have medical needs at home after discharge. The role of nurses at the hospital is transferred to the patient's family and increases the physical, psychological, and social burdens of the patient's family. Home care relieves family burdens and provides continuous medical interventions through safer and higher quality of medical services. This is done by providing home visits and education to solve these problems.

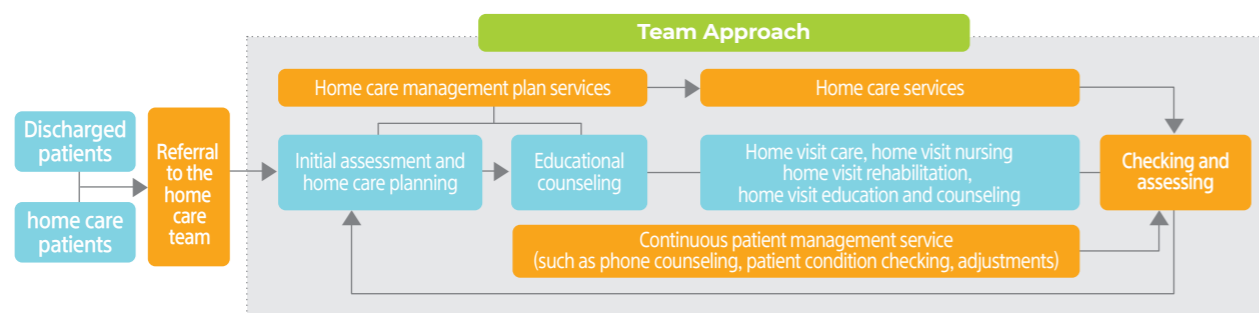

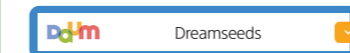

Se-yong Yun Nanumi volunteer [Classes 7, 8, 9, 10, 11, 12 and 13 scheduled]

Seeing him spending fun time with children and the way he watches children with so much love in his eyes during playtime is impressive. Because of his warmhearted look, people sometimes think he is a father of a child. The story of Se-yong who always have a great big smile whenever he sees babies, shall we listen to it?

1 You were voted as the Nanumi volunteer who takes the longest preparation time. We would like to hear your thoughts on how you prepare for activities before you go to see the children!

- I also thought that my preparation takes too long and I am always troubled by it. I feel a little embarrassed to know that my preparation time is the longest. As more time passes with the same children I take care of, I get worried that they may get bored with the same toys all the time, so I spend a lot of time trying to find new toys and new activities.

2 During the past five classes, you were the only man in all classes. Do you have any special episode to share because you were the only man?

- After a birthday party with the Friday afternoon team, I was asked to take off balloons that were hung high, but I was embarrassed because I was not able to reach them either.

3 You consistently work with infants. Do you have any know-how of your own or good methods of play?

- Although I do not have any special know-how, I think it is important to make eye contact when you talk to them. By doing that, I feel I have better rapport with them, and they also appear to focus on activities better. Many infants like to play with balloons. Plays like dropping balloons from a height or touching balloons may work well.

4 Do you have anything to say to the infants you meet?

- As they are loved and are a great pleasure to many people, I would like them to grow healthier to be loved by even more people.

5 Teacher Se-yong takes a long time to prepare, and his activity time is also the longest! You always look so happy when you come back from the ward.

- When you do activities with these children, there are times when they are amused and have bright smiles. When you see it, you really lose track of time while doing activities. There was an occasion when I held a baby in my arms. When his mother asked him to come, he turned his head away, showing that he does not want to go to his mother. He was so lovely, and it was very hard for me to leave him.

6 What does Dreamseeds mean to you?

- It is a place that gives me great joy and happiness for a whole week. Even if I had bad things for a whole week, I can forget all about it and muster my strength. I always receive more from my young friends than I give as I work at Dreamseeds. Now I will do my best for Dreamseeds to give them even more.

Cancer treatment itself is mentally and physically demanding but limited outside activities and "social isolation" of not being able to meet friends of the same age as much as my child wants to, due to low immunity, is a great sadness to the sick child and parents. In the midst of it, Dreamseeds became a great joy for our child. No matter how difficult the treatment was, when I say: "Let's go to hospital and visit Dreamseeds," he would put his hands together saying, "Tomorrow we go to Dreamseeds, right?" and fall asleep. He looks forward to go to Dreamseeds all day long. When playtime with Nanumi volunteer is up and I come to Dreamseeds to pick him up, he looks at me with deep resentment in his eyes (you came too early...) When I see my child is sad because playtime with the Nanumi volunteer passes too soon, I just want to say a big thank-you for the existence of Dreamseeds. I want to thank the coordinator and Nanumi volunteers for always greeting my child with a cheerful look.

Hi, I am the mother of Se-hwan Park who suffers from a rare disease called dermatomyositis. When he became sick, he was very shy and screamed when he saw a stranger, but he improved a lot after seeing a social worker at Dreamseeds Center. **The social worker always treats my son with ease and kindness. She connects with him at his eye level, which made Se-hwan open up to her and he likes the social worker so much. Due to the support from the Kids & Future Foundation, we met the social worker and it improved my son's mind and body. I want to thank the Kids & Future Foundation.** ♡



2 Thank you letter from the mother of 00 Choe who is receiving home-based swallowing rehabilitation

Hi everyone. I am the mother of a 16-month old baby. My child was born very small at 1.1 kg in September 2012 when she was 27th gestational week and three days old. She has been in the hospital for four months since her birth, and we were worried about her survival in the beginning and then about her health afterward.

Fortunately, despite tracheotomy, she came home safely in January 2019. When we had no more wishes, only that she could be fed through the mouth, we were contacted by the home care team of Seoul National University Hospital who informed us that home-based swallowing rehabilitation is possible. When I think about that moment: it felt like a beam of light coming down from heaven - even now. The therapist visited us at home and taught us oral massage methods, feeding posture and a pattern appropriate for my daughter. We practiced hard and fed according to the instructions. In about three months, the nasal tube came off. We decided to try and feed the baby through the mouth, and in three days, the amount of oral feeding increased, and we removed the nasal tube. Even after the nasal tube was removed, the therapist continued to teach us how to feed our baby, massage to desensitize the oral cavity that became sensitive by long-term tracheal intubation, and methods to have my baby experience various food. Due to consistent practice, my daughter can taste various types of food "by herself." **If my daughter did not have the home-based swallowing rehabilitation, I think she may still have difficulty eating through the mouth. I am so grateful for the swallowing rehabilitation program we had at that time. Eating through the mouth may be very ordinary to people, but for children who have difficulty with such an ordinary thing, resources like this is very precious and we are thankful for the opportunity.** We hope that more resources like this become available so that children who really need such treatment will receive it before it is too late.

Again, I want to thank you for the support on swallowing rehabilitation for one year, and we will raise our daughter (who received help from so many people) healthy and as a person who help others.

P.S. Thank you so much for letting us write this thank-you letter on the day, which is exactly one year since my daughter was discharged. ♥

Hi everyone. I am the mother of a pediatric patient who suffers from swallowing difficulty. It was difficult for our child to go to the rehabilitation center due to his limited mobility, but now we are receiving great help because he was selected for the home-based swallowing rehabilitation of the Seoul National University Hospital, supported by the Kids & Future Foundation. We were helpless and ignorant as to how to assist swallowing therapy at home, but now we are learning methods appropriate for our child, following the guidance of the therapist. In particular, it was great to be able to try chewing, rather than stopping at swallowing, under the guidance of the therapist.

Lastly, I would like to give my deep appreciation to "the Kids & Future Foundation" for its support and the palliative care team and home care team of Seoul National University Hospital.

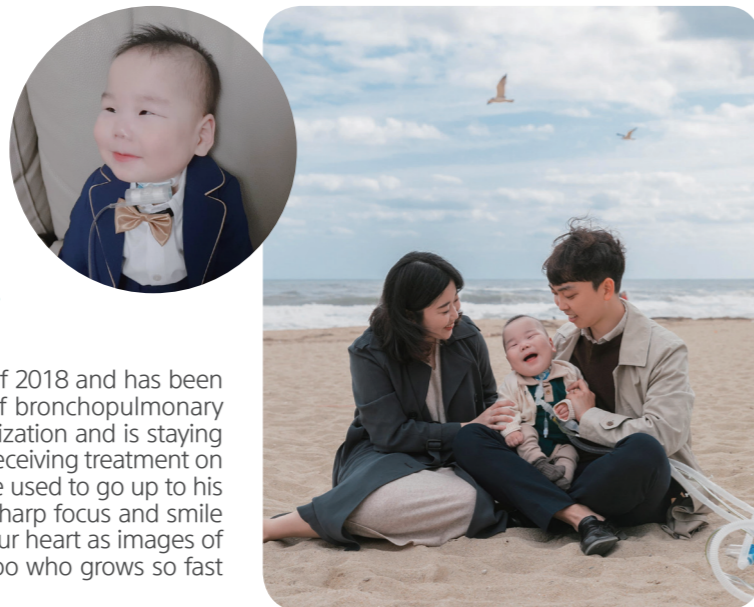

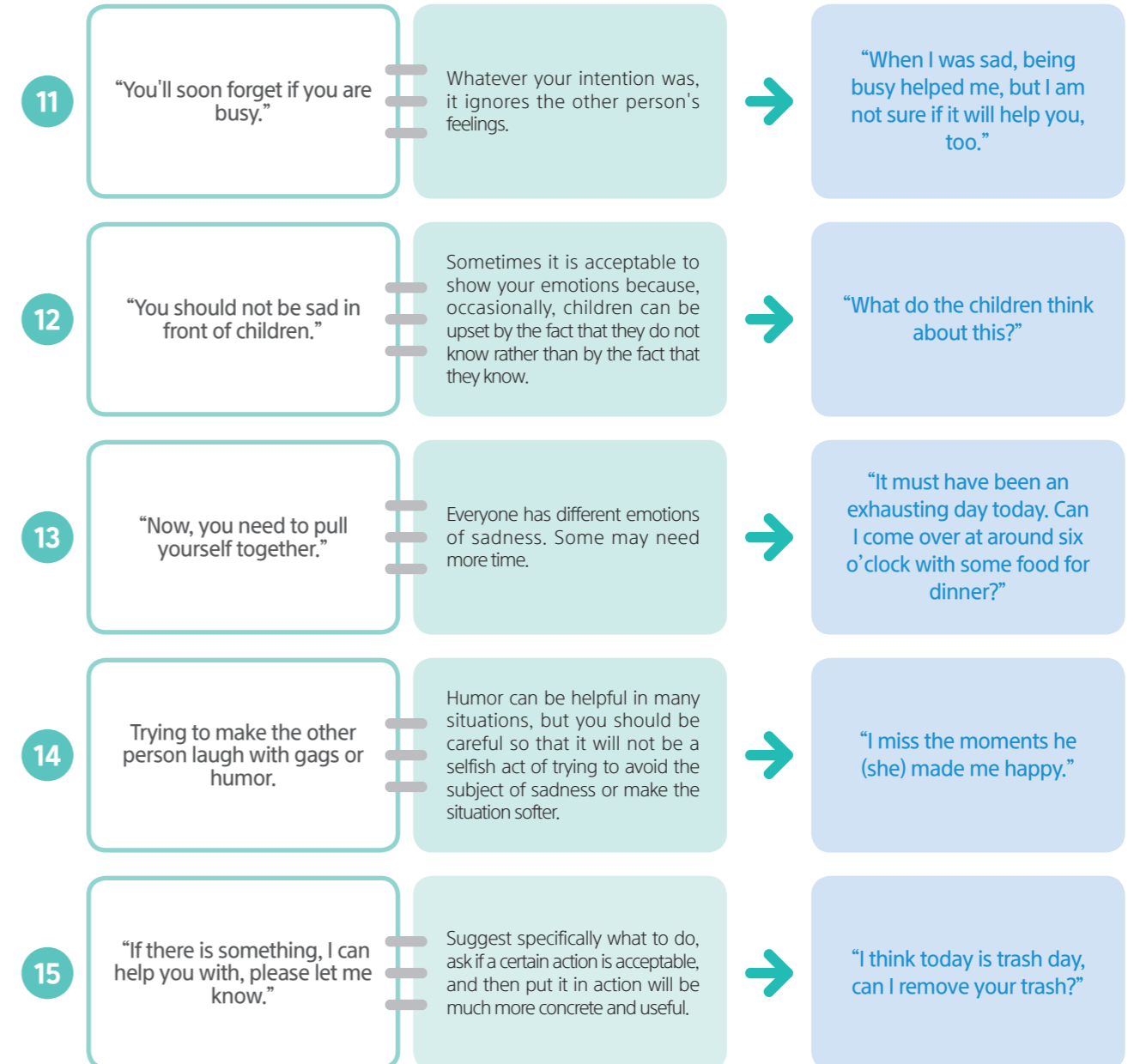
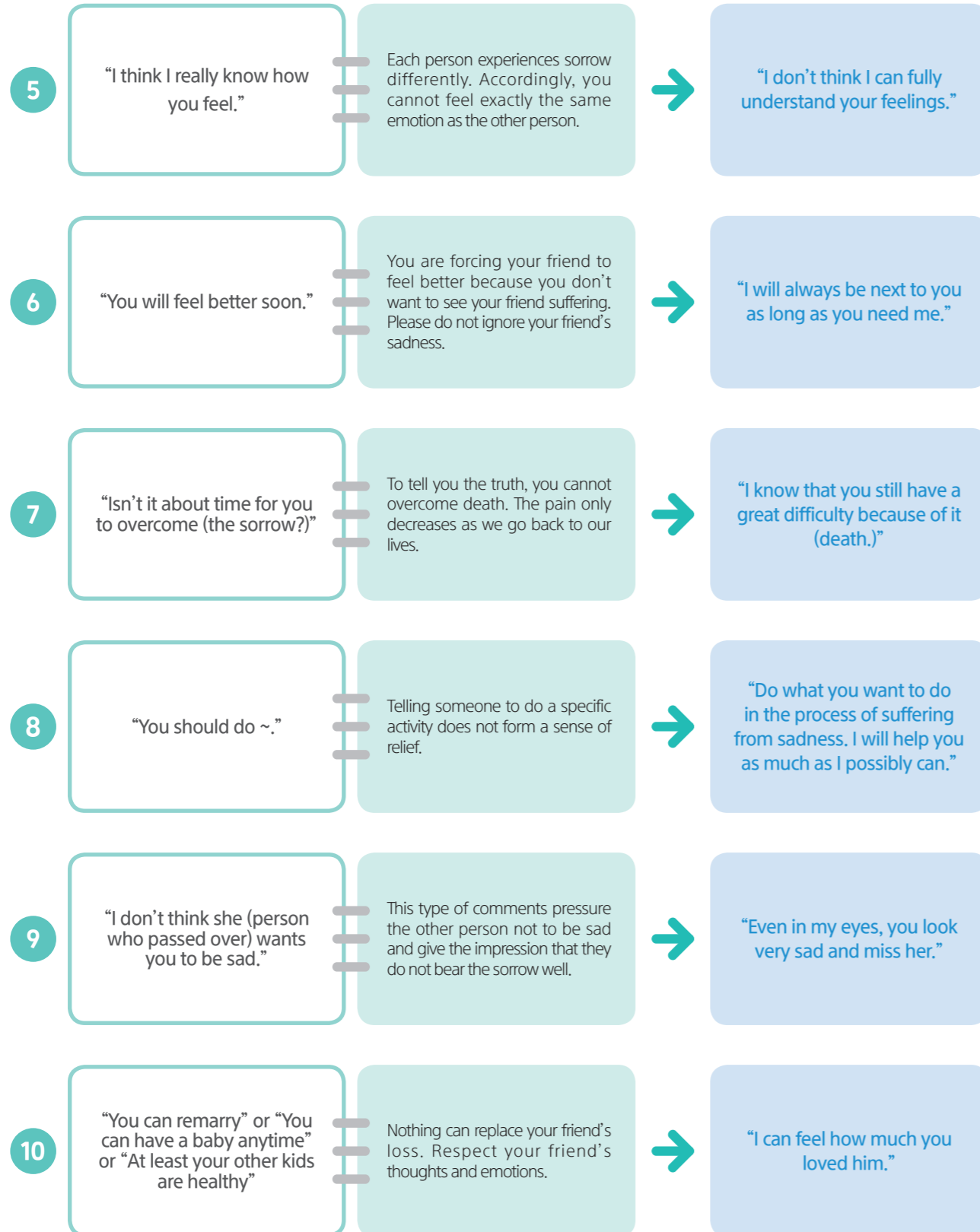
Sharing good writing that may be helpful

Many people experience a loss in life. When we hear from a close friend or a family member who experienced loss, we sometimes badly hurt our love ones by saying something mindlessly because we were in confusion or did not know what words of comfort to give. We want to introduce you to words that are not very helpful although your intention is good. In addition, we want to share a total of 15 better ways to deliver your good intention of comforting someone. We hope this writing helps those whose hearts are broken by loss and everybody who wants to share the sadness.

Bad expressions (Recognize common mistakes)	What could be the problem? (Think about it.)	Change to a good expression (Express it again)
1 “God gives you as much suffering as you can handle.”	Even if the other person believes in god, the sentence gives a message that “If you do not overcome this suffering, it means your belief in god is lacking or you are a bad Christian.”	→ “This must be very harsh on you.”
2 “It will be all good in the end.”	You must not say this because the person who is in sorrow thinks that there is no other situation that could be better than bringing the loved one back.	→ “I just don’t understand why these things happen.”
3 Saying nothing.	Ignoring the person’s pain is one of the worst behaviors for the person in sadness experiences. If you are not sure what to say or if you are uncertain if the other person wants to talk about it, then it is better just to say it.	→ “I don’t know what to say, but I want you to know that I am always right next to you.”
4 “He must be happier” or “You should be happy because he is not suffering anymore.”	Regardless of how painful it was or how difficult to attend the patient, the person in sorrow wants the loved one in pain with him or her.	→ “You must be really missing him.”



A small thoughtful consideration can be a present to your precious friend and family in sorrow. Have a warm and comfortable day together with a small change.

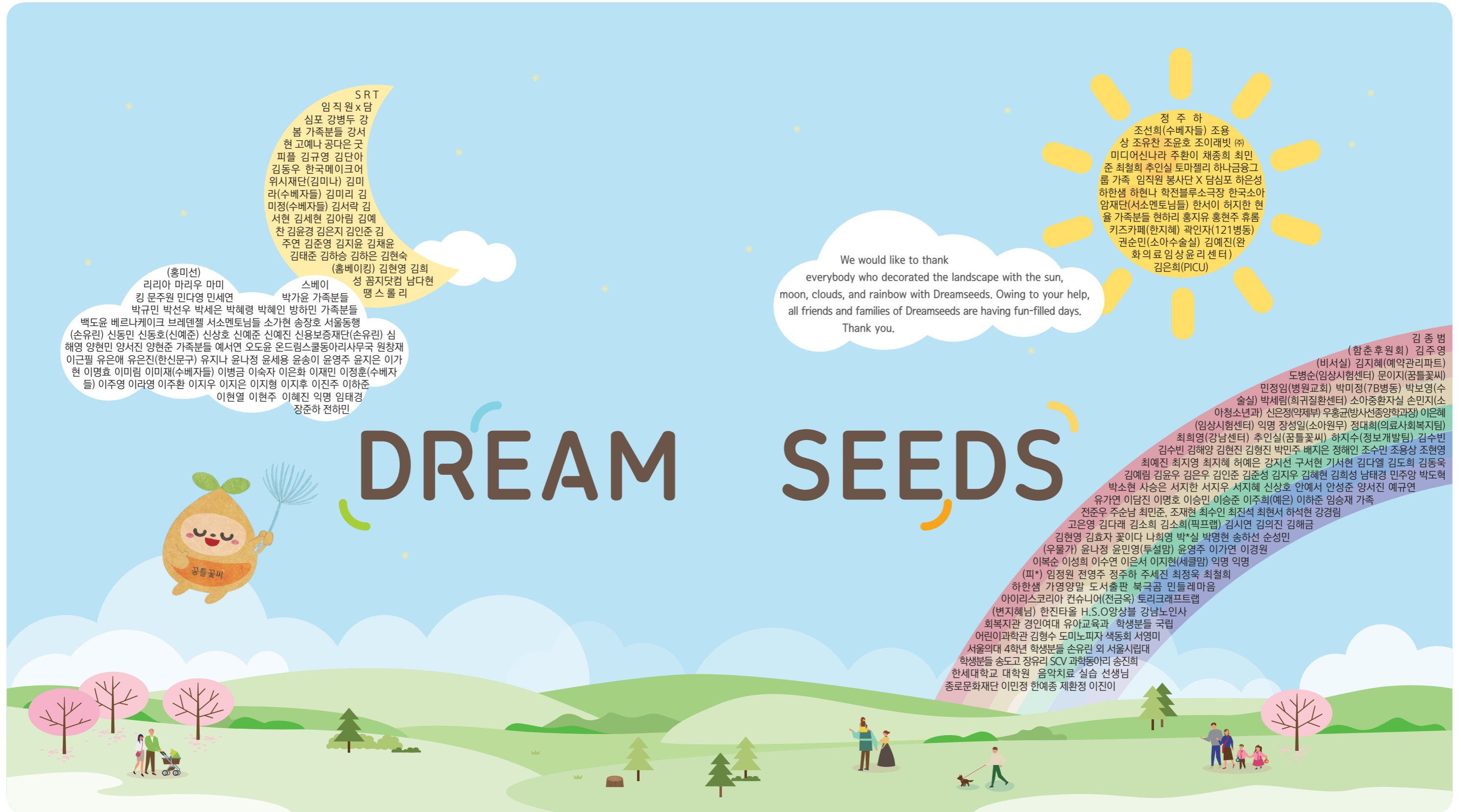

I would like to be happy so that I can do more and more good things! Being healthy is the best!

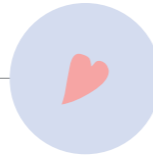
Q5
